  - a. All sustained complaints or findings of misconduct;
  - b. All complaints or investigations of misconduct that were pending at any point during the arrest or prosecution of Mr. [REDACTED] (i.e. since [REDACTED]), even if they were not ultimately sustained against those officers.
  - c. Confirmation of the steps that the USAO has taken to obtain this information.

~~(2) Identification of all radio channels used by officers to communicate during the investigation and arrest of Mr. [REDACTED] even if the USAO or MPD officers believe them to be unrecorded.~~

~~(3) Information regarding the MPD Gun Recovery Unit for the time period spanning January 1, 2014 present, including:~~

- a. ~~The total number of stops based on a vehicle occupant not wearing a seatbelt (or, if that level of specificity is not available, based on traffic violations);~~
- b. ~~The respective percentages (or number) of those stops in which the individual stopped was (a) African American and (b) white;~~
